Outstanding issues:

- 1) Appeal against **Enforcement Notice 19/00302/ENBOC by Brington LLP Site address:** Land South of Hill Place, Brington, Cambs PE28 5BP, no feedback on the Appeal.
HDC confirmed that Local Planning Authority (LPA) declined to determine this application as there is an outstanding enforcement case on the site which itself is contrary to the original conditions on the site to retain/plant the orchard.
This is a legal standpoint. Given the above the LPA are very unlikely to allow any development on this site.
Reason: In accordance with Section 70C of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) a Local Planning Authority may decline to determine an application where the grant of permission would relate to a breach of planning control which is specified in a pre-existing enforcement notice which relates to the whole or part of the land.
In this instance, enforcement notice reference 19/00302/ENBOC was issued by the Local Planning Authority on 12th April 2023 requiring, inter alia, works on the land to which this application relates, and which would not be capable of being carried out in the event of the grant of planning permission for this application. It is noted that planning application 22/00951/FUL for a materially similar development was previously refused and it is therefore considered expedient to

engage Section 70C of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)
