As advised by Highways officer, PC applied for Privately Funded HI scheme:

1. The current Brook Lane 30mph speed posts are after Sworders Yard. School buses drop off in a 60mph zone before Sworders Yard. Move current 30MPH signs to new posts further out of the village to extend 30mph zone.

2. The current Church Road 30mph zone starts near Molesworth church. Before you reach the church is Molesworth Village Hall, Molesworth Millenium Green green space and MUGA. Also the entrance to Molesworth Industries is within the Church Road 60mph zone. Therefore, move the current 30mph signs back down Church Lane to new posts nearer the extrance to Church Lane with Thrapston Road. This would ensure Molesworth Industries, Molesworth village Hall, the MUGA and Millenium Green - green space are all located within the 30MPH zone.
