‘ 5. Use of Personal Devices (BYOD) Councillors and staff may use personal devices for council business compliance with this policy. Security Requirements: Devices must be protected by strong passwords, encryption (where possible), and up-to-date antivirus software.

Access to council data on personal devices must be controlled and subject to regular review.
